Kyogle/Casino COVID Case

You have probably heard that the Kyogle LGA is now under lockdown orders until the 11th of October, which is the 2nd week of school. This means that students from the Kyogle LGA will not be able to attend school until the 2nd week of Term 4 unless their parents are essential workers, and they need to be in school. Whilst frustrating, this equates to only three days of teaching time that students are missing out on class.

Our executive team on Tuesday will discuss what provisions we will make for remote learning, particularly in English and Mathematics in the Secondary school during this time. We normally run examinations during Term 4. We will also be discussing the value of proceeding with our normal program of examinations for this year and we will communicate these things in the middle of next week.
