Kyogle/Casino COVID Case

You may have heard that a Kyogle resident who works at the Casino Meatworks in admin has been found to be COVID positive. At this stage, we have not been put under lockdown orders, but that may change before school resumes. Rest assured I will communicate with you as soon as possible if we find out any information in that regard.

Year 12 School Formal

You may recall from my communication on the 9th of September that I had said that we would wait and see what new communication comes from the Government regarding School Formals. At this stage, it looks like School Formals may be able to go ahead from the 1st of December. Our School Formal had been rebooked for the 2nd of December. Do not send them to school if they have COVID-like symptoms. Additionally, High School students should continue to bring a mask to school when Term 4 commences.
