



COVID Communication – 9th December 2021

Casino Christian School has been advised by NSW Health that a member of the school community has tested positive for COVID-19. This person was present at the school on the 6th December.

NSW Health has requested anyone who has been unwell or if you develop any symptoms such as a fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of smell/taste, muscle/joint pains, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting or extreme tiredness to be tested at one of the [COVID-19 testing clinics](#).

Whilst not a requirement of NSW Health, if a member of your family attended school this week, you may consider it prudent for them to self-isolate and get tested until they receive further advice.

NSW Health do not release information regarding the identity of the person who has tested positive for COVID-19.
