Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure students wear clothing that is consistent with the school's identity and values, promoting a positive culture within the school and the community.

Policy

- Students are required to wear full uniform to and from, and at school, as well as during excursions unless directed otherwise.
- If a student is not able to wear the full school uniform on a particular day, then they should present a note, signed by the parent or guardian, explaining the reason that they are unable to wear the uniform.
- Students who are out of uniform should present themselves to the coordinator on duty in B3 at lunch time. If students do not have a note from their parents, this may result in detention or further disciplinary actions.
- Failure to wear correct uniform may result in the student being unable to participate in certain activities.

Uniform Shop

- With the exception of shoes, all school uniform items can only be bought from our CCS School Uniform Shop (Room A1, Monday 8 am – 11 am, Wednesday 1 pm – 4 pm)

Secondary Girl's Uniform – Years 7 to 10

- Skirt: Ink navy blue pleated skirt
- Shorts: Ink navy blue plain dress shorts
- Trousers: Ink navy blue slacks
- Blouse: Cotton blue and white check with contrast navy collar and sleeve cuff with school emblem
- Socks: Ink navy blue
- Shoes: Black polishable school shoes/jogger (*see secondary shoe list. NB: Open top and soft ballet-type shoes are not WH&S compliant for Secondary classes, so are not allowed*)
- Hat: Ink navy blue with gold trim, full brim

Secondary Girl's Sport Uniform – Years 7 to 12

- Shirt: Gold polo with inserted navy side panels and a contrast placket, gold collar and cuff with navy trim with school emblem
- Shorts: Ink navy blue microfibre sports shorts with CCS logo
- Socks: Ink navy socks
- Shoes: Black polishable jogger (other sports shoes may be brought to school to change into for sport. Students should change into black shoes after sport)
- Hat: Ink navy blue with gold trim, full brim
- Tracksuit: Ink blue microfibre pants with gold piping and CCS logo
- Ink blue microfibre zipped jacket with gold piping and school emblem
- Tracksuit pants to be worn on sports and representative sports days only

Secondary Girl's Uniform – Years 11 to 12

- Skirt: Ink navy blue pleated skirt
- Shorts: Ink navy blue plain dress shorts
- Trousers: Ink navy blue slacks
- Blouse: Cotton blue blouse with trims
- Socks: Ink navy blue
- Shoes: Black polishable school shoes/jogger (*see secondary shoe list. NB: Open top and soft ballet-type shoes are not WH&S compliant for Secondary classes, so are not allowed*)
- Hat: Ink navy blue with gold trim, full brim

Secondary Boy's Uniform – Years 7 to 10

- Shirt: Ink navy blue polo with inserted gold side panels and a contrast placket, ink navy collar and cuff with gold trim with school emblem
- Shorts: Ink navy blue shorts
- Trousers: Ink navy blue trousers
- Socks: Ink navy blue
- Shoes: Black polishable school shoes/joggers (*see secondary shoe list*)
- Hat: Ink navy blue with gold trim, full brim

Secondary Boy's Sport Uniform – Years 7 to 12

- Shirt: Gold polo with inserted navy side panels and a contrast placket, gold collar and cuff with navy trim with school emblem
- Shorts: Ink navy blue microfibre sports shorts with CCS logo
- Socks: Ink navy blue
- Shoes: Black polishable jogger (other sports shoes may be brought to school to change into for sport. Students should change into black shoes after sport)

- Hat: Ink navy blue with gold trim, full brim
- Tracksuit: Ink blue microfibre pants with gold piping and CCS logo
- Ink blue microfibre zippered jacket with gold piping and school emblem
- Tracksuit pants to be worn on sports and representative sports days only

Secondary Boy's Uniform – Years 11 to 12

- Shirt: Cotton blue shirt with embroidered school name.
- Shorts: Ink navy blue melange shorts
- Trousers: Ink navy blue melange trousers
- Socks: Short ink navy blue
- Shoes: Black polishable school shoes/joggers (see secondary shoe list - no boots)
- Hat: Ink navy blue with gold trim, full brim

Secondary Girls/Boys options for cooler days

- Jumper: Ink navy blue V-necked fleecy-lined jumper with school emblem
- Ink navy blue zip jacket with school emblem
- School tracksuit top
- Special commemorative jumper (Year 11 & 12 students only)

Please label all jumpers with student's name.

Hats

- Students must wear their school hats when outdoors all throughout the year. Please label with student's name.

Hair

- Hair bands are to be ink navy blue, gold or white. A combination may also be worn. Scrunchies can also be made out of the same colours.
- For both boys and girls, haircuts should be **modest** - (i.e. not seeking to draw attention to yourself). Hair colours or dyes must not be outside the natural range of human hair colours, and only one colour at a time may be worn).
- Hairstyles are subject to the approval of the Principal.

Jewellery / Makeup

- For reasons of safety, bracelets and necklaces are not allowed.
- Students may wear earrings on the condition they are plain studs or sleepers and limited to two in each ear. Other body and facial jewellery are not allowed. If a student has a nose piercing then they should use a clear, small, plastic stud.
- Girls may wear light makeup and clear nail polish (no eyeliner).

Insignia

- The following garments require school emblems:
 - 7-12 Jumpers, Jackets, Sports Shirts
 - 7-10 Blouses, Shirts
- The following garments require embroidered school name:
 - 11-12 Boys Shirts
- If emblems need to be replaced, they can be purchased from the uniform shop.

Primary School Uniform

Primary Girl's Uniform - Kindergarten to Year 6

- Skirt/Culottes: Royal blue tartan (choice of either)
- Blouse: Royal blue, with tartan collar, cuffs, gold trim with school emblem
- Socks: Royal blue

- Shoes: Black polishable school shoes/jogger (see Primary shoe list)
- Hat: Royal blue, full brim hat

Primary Girl's Sport Uniform - Kindergarten to Year 6

- Shirt: Gold polo with inserted royal side panels and a contrast placket, gold collar with royal trim with school emblem
- Shorts: Royal blue knit shorts
- Socks: Royal blue
- Shoes: Black polishable jogger
- Hat: Royal blue, full brim hat

Primary Girl's options for cooler days

- Royal blue V-necked fleecy-lined jumper with school emblem
- Royal blue zip jacket with school emblem
- Royal blue track pants
- Black or navy tights
- *Please label all jumpers with student's name.*

Primary Boy's uniform - Kindergarten to Year 6

- Shirt: Royal blue polo with inserted gold side panels and a contrast placket, Royal blue collar with gold trim with school emblem
- Shorts: Royal blue school shorts
- Socks: Royal blue
- Shoes: Black polishable school shoes/jogger (see Primary shoe list)
- Hat: Royal blue, full brim hat

Primary Boy's sport uniform - Kindergarten to Year 6

- Shirt: Gold polo with inserted royal blue panels, gold collar with royal blue trim with school emblem
- Shorts: Choice of royal blue school shorts or royal blue knit shorts.
- Socks: Short royal blue
- Shoes: Black polishable jogger
- Hat: Royal blue, full brim hat

Primary Boy's options for cooler days

- Royal blue V-necked fleecy-lined jumper with school emblem
- Royal blue zip jacket with school emblem
- Royal blue track pants
- *Please label all jumpers with student's name.*

Hats

- Students must wear their school hats when outdoors all throughout the year. Please label with student's name.

Hair

- Hair bands are to be royal blue, gold or a combination of the two. Scrunchies can also be made out of the same colours.
- It is recommended that hair longer than shoulder length be tied back in ponytails or braided, and fringes are to be kept out of the eyes.
- Both boy's and girl's haircuts should be **modest** - (i.e. not seeking to draw attention to yourself). Hair colours or dyes are not accepted for primary age children.
- Hairstyles are subject to the approval of the Principal.

Jewellery / Makeup

- For reasons of safety, bracelets and necklaces are not allowed.
- Students may wear earrings on the condition they are plain studs or sleepers and limited to two in each ear. Other body and facial jewellery are not allowed. If a student has a nose piercing then they should use a clear, small, plastic stud.
- Students may not wear makeup or nail polish.

Insignia

- The following garments require school emblems:
 - K-6 Blouses, Shirts, Jumpers, Jackets
- If emblems need to be replaced, they can be purchased from the uniform shop.
