







Tumble Monkeys is an exciting program for young children with their carers. It encourages learning through play and physical activity.

The weekly program nurtures growing minds and bodies with engaging, active play. Children find joy in the exploration of movement and space, and gain confidence in themselves all while building friendships and developing social interaction skills.


The morning is semi-structured so that with the free-play there are a variety of skills and developmental focus areas for each particular week. Examples of this include: Jumping, Dancing, Ducking and Diving, Balance and Ball Skills, Bubbles and Bouncing, and Gym Skills. Children love the different ways to play and explore, think and move.

The warm and inviting environment fosters a sense of community for both adults and children, with morning tea and friendly conversations a regular part of each morning.

Tumble Monkeys, as an extension of CCS, welcomes all members of the community with preschool children. Feel welcome to join our weekly sessions, which run on a casual fee basis - \$5 for the first child, \$1 for any additional children with infants under one free.

School is an exciting place of learning and community and our Transition to School program helps students prepare for the start of the schooling journey in a beautifully nurturing way. The program allows students to learn classroom routines, build a relationship with their teacher and peers, develop their sense of community belonging and grow in excitement for the next stage of learning. We find that students who have undertaken the Transition to School program begin Kindergarten, confident, ready to achieve their best and be happy at school.

With experimentation play a key part of the program, students' natural curiosity is nurtured in an environment which promotes the wonder of learning. The educational benefits of the program are evident too. Our program incorporates activities that develop students' phonological awareness and numerical skills. This means that students are well positioned to take the next step to reading, writing, and numerical competency when they begin Kindergarten.

Our Transition to School program is for students in the year before they commence Kindergarten. The program runs in the second semester of each year (Terms 3 and 4) where students attend one day per week.

Students who go through the program start Kindergarten ready to learn, confident and excited about schooling.

The aim for our Primary students is to *develop a love of learning*, with a sense of *excitement and joy*. We believe that all students are gifted and talented and that students learn best when they are happy and engaged. Our environment fosters a cooperative approach to learning that encourages students' imagination and creativity.

The small school environment ensures that *each student is known and valued* for who they are. We endeavour to build strong and meaningful relationships with families and teach from the standpoint that we are partners with parents in the education of their children.

Growing in Faith

We Believe...

- in the Divine inspiration, the infallibility and supreme authority of the Old and New Testaments in their entirety and that the Holy Spirit so moved the writers that what they wrote are authoritative statements of truth for all matters of faith and conduct.
- there is one God in whom there are three equal Divine Persons, revealed as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, and who of His own sovereign will created the heavens, the earth and all that is contained in the Universe.
- the Lord Jesus Christ is the eternally existing, only begotten Son of the Father, conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. As God He became flesh and dwelt among us: as man He was God.
- all people are in a fallen, sinful and lost condition through the rebellion of Adam and Eve, who were created without sin, and in this state of depravity are helpless to save themselves and are under the condemnation of God to eternal punishment in Hell.

It is the indwelling Spirit who bestows the Gifts of the Spirit and manifests the Fruit of the Spirit in the believer.
- Christ died for our sins, was buried and the third day rose from the dead: that He appeared to real people who touched Him and knew His bodily presence and that He ascended to His Father.
- the Lord Jesus Christ will return in person with His saints and that the full consummation of the Kingdom of God awaits His return.
- those who have been regenerated by the Holy Spirit will receive a resurrection body at the return of Jesus Christ and be forever with the Lord, while those who have not believed will be resurrected to stand at the Judgement Seat of God to receive His judgement and eternal condemnation to Hell.

- in the actual existence of Satan who is the father of all evil and opposed to God although ultimately subject to the purposes of God and destined to be confined forever to Hell.
- the Church is the Body of Christ composed of all believers in the Lord Jesus Christ, which finds its visible manifestation in the local community of believers and ministers through the co-operative exercise of God-given gifts by the entire membership. Each local community of believers is competent under Christ as Head of the Church to order its life without interference from any authority whether civil or ecclesiastical.
