

School Cross Country TOMORROW

On Friday 5th May, our school will have its cross-country event for those turning 8 and upwards in 2022. Please ensure that students wear their sports uniform to school. Students may bring appropriate sun safe and modest clothes to change into for the actual run (including separate old shoes in a plastic bag as some parts of the course are muddy). When they finish their race, they are expected to change back into their sports uniform including regular school shoes. Family members are invited to come and watch on the day.

Students should bring some money to spend at the canteen during the carnival. However, it is advised that students bring their own healthy food just in case the canteen doesn't provide the healthy food they need to get them through the day. There will be no lunch orders for students turning 8 and upwards in 2022.

What to wear: Students are to wear sports uniform to school, and bring spare clothes and spare shoes to run in. The course tends to become very muddy, so appropriate old clothes are recommended. Bring a hat, sunscreen, water bottle and any medication they may require (e.g. Asthma puffer)



You only have to bring in the note once. Each Wed / Fri afterwards just let the bus 7 driver know you'll be getting off at the Church and they'll stop there for you.


No signed note = no getting off at Church

No bus pass? Just bring \$2 each Wed / Fri, and give that to the driver when you get on in the afternoon (plus your signed note).


