COVID19 and Respiratory Illnesses

As part of our review processes this morning the Executive Team met to discuss the management of COVID-19 and other respiratory illnesses as we have a significant amount of students and staff sick.

The AIS (Association of Independent Schools) Guidelines currently state that,

"Independent schools can determine their own school-based requirements for managing respiratory illness within the school community."

The AIS also suggest considering the NSW Health advice. Currently they have advised organisations that there are no mandatory requirements but strongly recommend that students and staff do not attend school if they have acute symptoms such as coughing, fevers, a runny nose and/or acute sore throats.

However, NSW Health also advise that whilst people may be infectious for up to 10 days, they are actually most contagious in the two days BEFORE symptoms start. This makes it nearly impossible to detect or prevent in classrooms and school settings.

We encourage all our students, staff and community to always use the sanitiser provided when entering and exiting rooms, practise good hygiene when blowing their nose or coughing, and regularly wash their hands. Students are not to share waterbottles, drinks or food as a regular school rule, and we remain vigilant in this space. Our cleaning staff also continue to regularly clean the desks in classrooms and in high touch areas.

As always, we encourage common sense when it comes to any illness, including COVID -19. If your child is sick, please don't send them to school. If they have a fever or bad cough, please keep them home. If their symptoms have subsided and they seem well enough to attend, they are welcome to attend, but it may be helpful for you to let the Office or Teaching Staff know so they can minimise any risk in the classrooms.

If you wish to collect more COVID-19 tests, you can get free RATs at Service NSW service centres, mobile service centres and recovery centres. There is no eligibility criteria and free RATs are available to all customers. Please know, there is no requirement to test or wear masks; however, can we please respectfully ask that students who are unwell are not sent to school to help keep our at-risk school community members safe.





Here are some tips on how to use the app!


To see the latest communications

Tap on the drop-down menu on the top left of the screen and tap on 'Home'




To search for a specific item posted

Tap on the drop-down menu on the top left of the screen and tap on 'Calendar'




Dignity Drive

(parent name, signature, & date)


- Get on bus 7 in the afternoon and give that note to the driver.
