

There are many other much larger building plans, including new classrooms, a new canteen, and a new purpose-built oval which are all in the works. Unfortunately, the constraints in the building industry nationwide have delayed our construction plans in other projects such as Before and After School Care. These circumstances are often outside of our control, but we rest safely in God's plans and his timing for these projects.

We are also called to be good stewards of what God has blessed us here with, and as such, we are improving our current older solar system to ensure we reduce our carbon footprint and use those savings to provide better resources for our students. We want to support them to do more of the fun things at school. Things such as our next musical production in 2024, and upgrading our Chromebooks and technology for our students.

(parent name, signature, & date)


- Get on bus 7 in the afternoon and give that note to the driver.
